

Route 1

From the North (MI Junction 26)

Follow the A610 towards Nottingham city centre. Travel approximately three miles; you are now on ALFRETON ROAD, (a long uphill with shops on either side). At the traffic lights at the top of the hill, follow the one-way street (WOLLATON STREET) downhill staying in the right-hand lane. At the first set of traffic lights mid-way down the hill, bear right (Tollhouse) between two buildings linked by a bridge (IBM is on either side of this bridge) Continue ahead descending the hill (MAID MARRION WAY), over the island. Down to the bottom of the hill, under a bridge to a set of traffic lights (nightclub opposite). This is one-way (COLIN STREET). There is a multi-storey car park on the right, and The Broadmarsh shopping centre on the left. Follow the signs for TRENT BRIDGE (cricket ground), following the road round to the right and then take the left fork at the traffic lights to the next set of traffic lights into CANAL STREET.

Proceed to the traffic island. The BBC is Opposite. Turn RIGHT (2nd exit). This is LONDON ROAD. Follow this over TRENT BRIDGE (over the River Trent), in the LEFT (of 3) lanes, through the traffic lights, and take the THIRD LEFT into BRIDGFORD ROAD (at the rear of The Trent Bridge Inn / Cricket Ground). After 100 metres, turn RIGHT into MUSTERS ROAD. We are the first office building on the LEFT-hand-side.

Route 2

From the A52 (Derby / MI Junction 25)

Follow the A52 towards Nottingham city centre. At the A52 / Queens Medical Centre (hospital) island, take the 3rd exit RIGHT. Continue over the flyover and keep on the lookout for the clearly visible SHOWCASE CINEMA on the opposite carriageway. Carry straight on, going past this, continuing over an incline, and then turn off LEFT signposted A52 / GRANTHAM. Approximately one mile ahead you come to a traffic island (signposted Football / Cricket traffic). Go straight over. Half a mile ahead, next traffic Island. Turn LEFT. This is the A60 / MELTON ROAD into WEST BRIDGFORD.

Travel for a couple of miles through 2 sets of traffic lights, passing shops, and a BP petrol station on your left. At the next traffic lights turn RIGHT, and immediately LEFT. This is signposted TRENT BRIDGE. You are now on MUSTERS ROAD. We are the last building on the right –hand side.

Route 3

From the South (Derby South / MI Junction 24)

Follow the A453 towards Nottingham city centre, through CLIFTON. After the hill descends past Nottingham Trent University Clifton Campus you descend to a set of traffic lights. Get in to the LEFT hand lane, and take the LEFT hand filter, signposted WILFORD / TRENT BRIDGE. At the end of the slip road, turn LEFT, and proceed over the mini – roundabout to the next set of traffic lights. Go straight on along WILFORD LANE, to the T-junction / traffic lights at the junction with LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD. Turn LEFT, and take the next RIGHT at the traffic lights (past the Mercedes dealership) into BRIDGFORD ROAD.

After 100 metres, turn RIGHT into MUSTERS ROAD.

Route 4

From the East (A52 Newark)

Follow the A52 to Gamston roundabout (first roundabout after Radcliffe on Trent). Take 2nd exit signed West Bridgford and City- centre. DO NOT turn into West Bridgford, but follow the signs for the city-centre for approximately 2 miles passing TRENT BRIDGE CRICKET GROUND / TRENT BRIDGE INN on your left-hand-side. At the T-junction / traffic lights at the Trent Bridge Inn, turn LEFT, and almost immediately, LEFT again. This is BRIDGFORD ROAD. After 100 metres, turn RIGHT into MUSTERS ROAD.

Route 5

From the South (Leicester / A60)

Follow the A606 through Tollerton to a large roundabout (Wheatcroft Garden Centre to the far left) which is crossed by the A52 ring road. Straight ahead (2nd) (signed WEST BRIDGFORD) into a built up residential area. This is the A60 / MELTON ROAD into WEST BRIDGFORD.

Travel for a couple of miles through 2 sets of traffic lights, passing shops, and a BP petrol station on your left. At the next traffic lights turn RIGHT, and immediately LEFT. This is signposted TRENT BRIDGE. You are now on MUSTERS ROAD. We are the last building on the right –hand side.

Route 6

From the North (Mansfield / A60)

Follow the A60 (MANSFIELD ROAD) towards Nottingham and continue until a roundabout 100 yards after the Moat House Hotel (on the left). Continue up the hill to a set of traffic lights and down the other side taking a left fork at the traffic lights after Neales Auction Rooms (on left). Follow this road (HUNTINGTON STREET) for approx. 2 miles, through traffic lights, passing, Office World, to your left. Get into the far left-hand lane, past the Nottingham Ice Stadium (on your right) to a roundabout. Take the 1st exit LEFT onto LONDON ROAD. You will pass the BBC offices on your LEFT.

Follow this over TRENT BRIDGE (over the River Trent) in the left (of 3) lanes, (over the river Trent), through the traffic lights, and take the third LEFT into BRIDGFORD ROAD (at the rear of The Trent Bridge Inn / Cricket Ground).

After 100 metres, turn RIGHT into MUSTERS ROAD.

From Nottingham Rail Station

We are 1.5 miles away from the rail station.

Taxi

Ranks in-front and to the right - hand side of the rail station on STATION STREET. We are a couple of minutes ride away.

Bus

Turn right out of the front of the station (CARRINGTON STREET), heading towards the Broadmarsh Shopping Centre. Cross over to that side, and bear right, to the appropriate bus stop. The most frequent bus is the No. 11. All buses marked WEST BRIDGFORD take you over TRENT BRIDGE. You will either stop on BRIDGFORD ROAD or just around its corner (next to the Mercedes dealership) on LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD. 100 meters off Bridgford Road (at the rear of Trent Bridge Cricket Ground / Trent Bridge Inn) turn RIGHT into MUSTERS ROAD.

The ride takes approximately 5 – 20 minutes, as some buses go around the city-centre to reach West Bridgford.
